What is the difference?

A donation is a one-time gift made now. It can be paid by credit card or by check. Here is a link to donate online with a credit card.

A pledge is an intention to give in the future. You also have the option to make up to three annual installments which enables donors to make a larger “total” gift.

For example, you'd like to donate \$1500, but can't really fit that into your budget all at once. You can break it up into three annual installments of \$500 per year. You will be recognized for a gift of \$1,500 as soon as your signed pledge form is processed!
